Singapore Badminton Association National Ranking System

(w.e.f. 1st January 2023)

Description:

The badminton players ranking system is an indicator of performance on court over a period of time. This system also helps to determine the player's seeding for SBA-organized and SBA-sanctioned tournaments.

The ranking points will be computed and publish in the tournament software and/or Singapore Badminton Association (SBA) website after every completed tournament.

Participants:

1. Only for Singapore Citizen, Permanent Resident and Long-Term Pass Holders (ie. Student Pass).

Validity:

1. Competitions that are listed in the tier table in this policy.

Point System:

- 1. The ranking system is a 52-week (1 year) cumulative system. Each player will be ranked according to his ranking points determined by his results in valid tournaments. A player with higher ranking points will be ranked above another player with lower ranking points.
- 2. Ranking Points Principles:
 - a) Ranking Points are awarded based on the final achieved positions in single events and doubles events.
 - b) The number of Ranking Points awarded is related to the event.
 - c) Ranking points gained from a particular competition in the previous year would be valid until the run of the same competition / period from the current year is over. If it is known that the competition will not be held in the current year, the points will stay valid for a period of 12 months.
 - For example, if Player X gained 400 points from SBA National Junior Championships in December 2018, these would expire after the end of December 2019's SBA National Junior Championships. In the event the December 2019's SBA National Junior Championships is cancelled; the points will expire as of December 2019. However, should the December 2019's SBA National Junior Championships be postponed to February 2020, the 400 points will still be valid between December 2019 to February 2020.
- 3. A player will have different rankings in the respective category he/she participated in. For example, A player who participated in U13 and in U15 and 'Open' event will have a different ranking in each event.
- 4. The Ranking point will be determined based on the last position he/she was in.

How it works:

Players gain points according to how far they progress in the draw of a particular event. If a player:

- Has a bye in the first round and loses in the second round they will receive the Second-round loser's points.
- Has a bye in the first round, wins the second round and loses in the third round they will receive the third-round loser's points.
- Has a walkover in the first round and loses in the second round they will receive the second-round loser's points.
- Has a bye in the first round, has a walkover in the second round and loses in the third round
 they will receive the third-round loser's points.

Classification of Competition:

1. Events of competitions will be classified into different tiers according to the estimated level of play. The amount of Ranking points will differ from tier to tier.

Points List:

- 1. If two or more players have identical points, the player who has played the least tournaments will be ranked higher.
- 2. If players have identical points and have also played in identical number of tournaments, these players will be ranked equally.

The Ranking points of the players will increase exponentially from the initial stage to the eventual winner.

Other notes:

- The Singapore Badminton Association (SBA) reserves the right to apply change ranking system regulations after every competition is completed.
- SBA decision will be final if there is a dispute / appeal / disagreement.

Frequently Asked Question:

Q: Why does the National ranking system only cater to Singaporeans, Permanent Residents & Long-Term Pass Holders?

A: This system is for the development of players residing in Singapore by allowing them to track their own rankings and compare their ranking amongst all other local players.

Q: Why is it based on an accumulation of 52 weeks?

A: To encourage more participation in our local tournament. Players are encouraged to participate as many competitions as possible to accumulate more points. Accumulation is only for 52 weeks (1 year) as it is easier for new players to 'catch up'. A good performance from the previous year gives the player a good seed position for this year competition and it also meant that players must maintain their performance to keep up their ranking.

Q: What benefits do I gain to be in a ranking system

A: A ranking systems helps to understand how well they perform on court and where they stand in the competitions they participate within a year. Participants will stand to gain when the better performers are seeded in the draw of the next competition to ensure avoid facing other top players in the first few rounds.

Q: What if my points were not updated correctly? Who should I contact?

A: The Ranking points were generated automatically by Tournament software. However, if in cases whereby the points were calculated wrongly, please send an email to SBA to rectify the issue. The final update of the ranking point may take up to 4 weeks for confirmation.

Q: What happen to my ranking if I change my double's partner?

A: If the pair decided to split and change partner for the other tournaments, both players will start from zero point when they decided to pair with different individuals for the next tournament.
