Singapore Badminton Association is inviting applications for the position of Singapore Badminton Assistant Singles Coach. We are aiming to enhance our current singles programme through the recruitment of a recognised Singles Coach with the aim of continuing the development and growth of our singles programme. This position is a full-time post, working with the rest of the Coaching team, to drive Singapore's Singles strategy toward further international success in the short and long term, whilst building on the recent success on the world stage. The successful candidate will work under the direction of the Singles Head Coach and the High Performance Team.

The Singles Assistant Coach will assist the Singles Head Coach with duties linked to the Singles programme, including: planning annual and weekly training programmes for the Singapore National Singles players, whilst also ensuring that the daily training environment is of high quality.

The successful candidate will possess the following attributes:

- A minimum of 2 years' experience coaching within a National Team structure with a primary focus on Singles
- Recent experience of working with international players and experience of international tournaments
- An understanding of annual planning and developing players
- Holds the BWF Level 1 qualification or equivalent as a minimum
- Candidates should have strong communication skills. Be fluent in speaking English as the primary language
- Have the ability to create a motivating training environment
- Have good team working abilities and understand the positives in the usage of sport science to enhance the performance of athletes

Singapore Badminton is offering a competitive salary that is reflective of our interests in attracting a world class coach to the programme.

Key responsibilities and main tasks and activities:

- Lead the planning and delivery of the annual and weekly training and competition plan for Singapore National Singles players
- Work in conjunction with the Singles Head Coach, NTS Coaches and NIS Coaches to enhance the technical abilities of players throughout the Singapore Singles Pathway
- Work with the Singles Head Coach to ensure that training and competition programmes for Singapore's developing Singles players are effective and reflective of progressive athlete development needs.
- Work closely with the Singles Head Coach and the High Performance Team in the management of the training environment
- Creating a strong emphasis on the overall team culture and discipline which aligns with the targets for the programme
- Develop a good relationship with dedicated Singapore Sports Institute staff
- Coaching of Singapore National and Developing players at international tournaments as required.

- Report to the Technical Director, High Performance Team and Singles Head Coach

Other Duties:

- To undertake other duties from time to time as reasonably required by the Technical Director
