	Registration is to be done and completed via link above. Failure to provide any required information will be deemed an invalid registration.  The closing date for registration is on 5th January 2024 (Friday), 10.00 am. Payment have to be made within 48 hours upon confirmation of entry. Late, unclear and incomplete entries will NOT be entertained. This registration fee is non-refundable.  A list of registered participants will be released on 19th January 2024. It is the players' responsibility to check the list and accuracy of information. SBA will not entertain any changes/appeal after 23rd January 2024, 12.00pm.		

### Registration Regulations w.e.f 2024

- Please note that there will be a change in registration regulation starting
  from National Open Championships 2024. With the establishment of the
  National Ranking System and sanction tournaments with ranking points
  across the year, future National Open Championships be accepting
  registrations based on players' BWF World, BWF Notional ranking points
  and the SBA National ranking points for the Open events and will no
  longer be on a first come first serve basis.

### Eligibility of Participants

- Players are required to bring along their ID and work passes along with payment confirmation for verification purposes.
- The Organisers may ask for proof of eligibility during the tournament.
   Anyone found ineligible will not be allowed to play and the player will have to <u>concede walkover</u> for any upcoming matches. There will <u>NOT</u> be any refund of <u>entry</u> fees.
- All players must have an active SBA Member ID.

### **Refund Policy**

There will be no refund of registration fees except for any cancellation of event by the Organizing Committee.

Prize Presentation shall be held on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2024 (Saturday) immediately after the finals of each event. It is mandatory for prizes winners to be present personally for the prize presentation ceremony in **proper sporting attire** in order to receive their prizes. No singlets, slippers and sandals are allowed. No display of flags, banners or goods in promotional nature by players while on podium. Any uncollected medals and prizes will be forfeited.

Competition Rules & Regulation	<ul> <li>Relevant Badminton World Federation Regulations shall be applicable to this competition.</li> <li>BWF World and BWF Notional Ranking will be used for seeding. National Ranking will be used should there be insufficient seeds from the BWF World and BWF Notional Ranking.</li> <li>The pre-requisite for having a BWF Notional Ranking is that at least one player in the pair must have played with different partners during the 52 weeks period prior to the seeding date.</li> <li>All players are requested to bring along their identification documents for verification on days of their matches.</li> <li>Once entries have been accepted; no replacement / substitution of players will be entertained. However, the Organising Committee, at its discretion, reserves the right to accept such changes if necessary and with valid reasons, so long as no match has been played by the player/s.</li> <li>All players are to report for registration and attendance-taking 30 minutes before the scheduled time of their matches.</li> <li>Match can be called up to 10 minutes earlier when players are ready.</li> <li>All matches will be played in accordance with the schedule of play. Postponement of any matches will be at the Organising Committee's discretion.</li> <li>Players will be given a grace period of a maximum 5 minutes for all matches, failing which the players fail to turn up, the match will be scrapped.</li> <li>Players shall wear non-marking shoes during the competition.</li> <li>The decision of the umpires and officials shall be deemed as final.</li> <li>There shall be line judges from Day 1 onwards.</li> <li>Retiring from a match shall not be considered a withdrawal. However, should a player be-entered in more than one event, by retiring or withdrawing from that one event, the player must be withdrawn from all others events in which the player is entered. A 'no show' for a match in a tournament shall be treated as walkover to the opposition.</li> </ul>	
Clothing (Players)	MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS  1. Doubles partners must wear clothing of the same colour and similar design. 2. Opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors. 3. Players to have their names on the back of the shirt.  Kindly prepare minimum two sets of clothing of significantly different colors.	
	Where both Players / Pairs have the same or no ranking, the Player or Pair listed lower in the ranking list made for the competition will be required to change the colour of clothing.  (GCR 21.6., BWF STATUTES Section 5.1.)	

Coaches	Only <b>TWO</b> coaches will be permitted per player/pair.  No usage of electronic devices while on the coach chair per BWF Regulations.
	<ol> <li>MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS</li> <li>Coaches must come in proper sporting attire (ie. Long pants and sport shoes)</li> <li>Coaches in improper attire (ie. Slippers, sandals, heels, jeans and dresses) will not be permitted in competition venue / field of play.</li> </ol>
	*Note: No food and drinks will be permitted in venue.
Dispute	In case of any dispute regarding the tournament and point of Law, Referee shall make the Final decision.
On Court Medic	<ul> <li>On Court Medic will be on duty throughout the competition at the tournament venue.</li> <li>Players can call for muscle spray from Court Medic ONCE per player per match except during intervals. Players are advised to bring their own spray to avoid undue delays.</li> <li>No prolong medical treatment shall be done on court. Referee shall advise the player and player should make the decision to play on or retire from the match.</li> </ul>
Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering, and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.  To protect the integrity of tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
Supplementary Rules	<ul> <li>The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the tournament at any time. Notification of such changes will be posted on <a href="http://www.singaporebadminton.org.sg/">http://www.singaporebadminton.org.sg/</a>.</li> <li>All participants are required to visit the site frequently for any announcements or changes to schedules.
