Payment will then have to be made by the deadline stated in the message. Entries will be deemed incomplete and invalid without payment completion and screenshot for verification. There will be no refund once payment has been made.

Prize Money & Medals

If there are less than 16 entries in any of the events, the prize money for that event may be reduced.

Medals will be rewarded to all Winners & Runners up.

It is <u>compulsory</u> for all Winners and Runners up to attend the Prize Presentation Ceremony.

Prize presentation shall be held on 17th January 2024 (Friday) immediately after the finals of each event. It is mandatory for prizes winners to be present personally for the prize presentation ceremony in **proper sporting attire** in order to receive their prizes. No singlets, slippers and sandals are allowed. No display of flags, banners or goods in promotional nature by players while on podium. Any uncollected medals and prizes will be forfeited.

Competition Rules & Regulation	 Relevant Badminton World Federation Regulations shall be applicable to this competition. BWF World and BWF Notional Ranking will be used for seeding. National Ranking will be used should there be insufficient seeds from the BWF World and BWF Notional Ranking. All players are requested to bring along their identification documents for verification on days of their matches. Once entries have been accepted; no replacement / substitution of players will be entertained. However, the Organising Committee, at its discretion, reserves the right to accept such changes if necessary and with valid reasons, so long as no match has been played by the player/s. All players are to report for registration and attendance-taking 30 minutes before the scheduled time of their matches. Match can be called up to 10 minutes earlier when players are ready. All matches will be played in accordance with the schedule of play. Postponement of any matches will be at the Organising Committee's discretion. Players will be given a grace period of a maximum of 5 minutes for all matches, failing which the player will concede a walkover for that match. In the event both players fail to turn up, the match will be scrapped. Players shall wear non-marking shoes during the competition. The decision of the umpires and officials shall be deemed as final. There shall be line judges from Day 1 onwards. Retiring from a match shall not be considered a withdrawal. However, should a player be entered in more than one event, by retiring or withdrawing from that one event, the player must be withdrawn from all others events in which the player is entered. A 'no show' for a match in a Tournament shall be treated as walkover to the opposition. 	



Clothing (Players)	MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS 1. Singles players must wear shirt and shorts/skirt of the same colour throughout a match. No change of colour is allowed during the match. 2. Doubles partners must wear shirts and shorts/skirt of the same colour and similar design throughout a match. No change of colour is allowed during the match 3. Opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors. Player/pair ranked lower will be required to wear clothing of a significantly different colour. Where both Players/pairs have the same or no ranking, the Player or pair listed lower in the latest version of Main Draw list will be required to change the colour of clothing (GCR 21.6., BWF STATUTES Section 5.1.) 4. Players to have their names on the back of the shirt. Kindly prepare TWO sets of clothing of significantly different colors.
Coaches	Maximum of TWO coaches will be permitted per player/pair. No usage of electronic devices while on the coach chair per BWF Regulations. Only coaches with FULL NROC Certified status are permitted to be on the coach chair and performing coaching during intervals. Non-certified coaches will NOT be allowed to be on coach chair and on court during intervals, but are allowed to watch in spectator role. MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS 1. Coaches must be in proper and acceptable badminton coaching sport attire (ie. Long pants and sport shoes) 2. Coaches in non-conformance attire (i.e. but not limited to slippers, sandals, heels, jeans and dresses) will NOT be permitted to sit on coach chair and/or to be on court coaching during intervals *Note: No food and drinks will be permitted in venue.
Dispute	In case of any dispute arising during the match, Referee's decision shall be final.
On Court Medic	On Court Medic will be on duty throughout the competition at the Tournament venue. Players may call for muscle spray from Court Medic ONCE per player per match except during intervals. Players are advised to bring their own spray and apply it with Umpire's permission to avoid undue delays except during intervals. No prolong medical treatment shall be done on court. Referee shall advise the player and player should make the decision to play on or retire from the match.



Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering, and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this Tournament. To protect the integrity of Tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.	
Supplementary Rules	 The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the Tournament at any time. Notification of such changes will be posted on https://www.singaporebadminton.org.sg/. All participants are required to visit the site frequently for any announcements or changes to schedules. It is the responsibility of all players to check your match schedule at https://sba.tournamentsoftware.com/. By agreeing to participate in this Tournament, you are granting SBA permission to use your and/or your child's images for promotional and publicities purposes. Data Protection Act 2012: By submitting my personal data on the registration form for the Tournament, I agree and consent to Singapore Badminton Association collecting, using, disclosing and sharing amongst the relevant parties my personal data for the purpose of contacting me by telephone, SMS and/or email for operational planning as well as communication of events, programmes, and SBA-related information and for any and all purposes allowed by law (express or implied).

The Organizer will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from his participation in these Championships. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and / or hospitalization shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned. Please ensure that your players & team officials possess the requisite insurance coverage to meet current requirements.
